Routledge Academic studies of 'terrorism' grew exponentially in number after the September 11 attacks. The problem was that much of this work of 'orthodox' terrorism studies was biased, often shoddily researched and was too closely identified with the power centres of Western states. In response the project of Critical Terrorism Studies was intended to give a more rounded account of political violence in the world. ## 11th September The Twin Towers Disaster

## The Event that Has Shaken New York, The United States and the Whole World

**On September 11, 2001, Saudi Arabia and other Arab countries hijacked 2 commercial Böing 767 aircraft and flown them into two world trade centers in New York City, Islamic terrorists attacked the United States in the early morning**

hours. On the morning of tragedy and confusion, many people tried to understand what was going on. When the first plane hit the World Trade Center tower at the north, some believed it to be an unfortunate aviation disaster, and then speculation was reported about an attack on America when another aircraft hit the other tower and the Pentagon. It was revealed that the terrorist attack was planned and carried out by a Saudi-Arab Islamic extremist named Osama Bin Laden and a terrorist group named Al-Qaeda. When millions watched TV and heard on the radio, two towers collapsed from damage to their facilities. This attack was the first major attack on American soil since Pearl Harbor on 7 December 1941. This attack also rivaled Pearl Harbor's death toll. On the morning of 11 September, over 3,000 men, women and children lost their lives. The Bush administration fought against Afghanistan soon after the attack and created the "war on terror." Saddam Hussein was seen as a global threat during this war on terror, and in 2003 America went to war with Iraq. The war was very controversial, as Osama Bin Laden was never caught and he fled from Afghanistan as many soldiers had moved to Iraq.
