University of Texas Press Although Roy Bedichek published less than his more famous friends J. Frank Dobie and Walter Prescott Webb, he wrote voluminously and, many say, with more distinction than the others. In addition to his four published books, Bedichek produced a great number of letters through which he communicated his broad interests and deep learning to a wide variety of correspondents. Prefaced by a biographical sketch, this volume presents a collection of Bedichek letters that give us an insight into his literary and creative development—from his earliest years through his career at the University of Texas and on into his later years. They include letters to his closest associates, J. Frank Dobie and Walter Prescott Webb, and to many old friends, such as William A. Owens, John A. Lomax, and John Henry Faulk. Also included is Bedichek's correspondence with other contemporaries, not all old friends, among them Texas Governor James Ferguson, the recipient of some of Bedichek's most trenchant criticism. Throughout this collection, Bedichek's sparkling wit and profound learning are evident as he discusses his favorite subjects, among them ecology, education, literature, politics, and history, frequently related to Texas. When Roy Bedichek gave his collection of letters to the Barker Collection in the University of Texas Library, he designated William A. Owens as the authorized editor of the letters, with the restriction that none of them be published until seven years following his death, which came in 1959.

THE FIRST HALF-CENTURY OF SMALL TOWN ATHLETIC HISTORY

Createspace Independent Publishing Platform Windham Ohio is a town so small one has to squint to see it in a Rand McNally atlas. Situated in the Western Reserve of northeastern Ohio, it is a cookie-cutter five mile square, just like every one of its neighboring townships in Portage County. Established in 1811 by 16 families from Becket Massachusetts, it spent its first 150 years as a rural community with a crossroads hamlet at its center. Windham built its first high school in 1883, and graduated its first class of four scholars in 1886. Because its population never rose above 300 for the first 130 years, the only organized sport at first was community baseball. Sometime after the turn of the twentieth century, the high school began sponsoring football teams on a field across the street from the wooden high school. These teams tended to exist or vanish from year to year, and none of them are remembered as being very good. The history of Windham athletics changes in 1927 with the construction of a new all-brick high school with the town's first gymnasium, on the site of the former football field. Beginning in that year, Windham had both boys and girls basketball teams. Football sponsorship continued to be haphazard during the 1930's, as the small high school often did not even have eleven boys enrolled at one time. That would soon change, and Windham became a completely different community after 1940, when the federal government appropriate half its land to build the Ravenna Arsenal, a bomb-making facility. But 1927 is where this history starts, taking the reader through chapters describing the girls basketball teams that rose to the top of their sport. Several chapters follow football teams that win state championships and are proclaimed the best in the world by experts. Boys basketball teams that win numerous conference trophies and sport the best records in the state of Ohio, the football team that become Portage County's first entry in the state football playoffs, Windham's role in the smallest athletic confederation in the history of the state - these are all part of Windham's heritage. And the longest chapters will dissect the career of Leo Kot, the most respected man to ever coach in Portage County, who scaled the heights of success in three different sports. Belden has spent many years researching the long-lost history of his alma mater's athletic history, and this book presents the story in a way that will touch the heart of any fan of small school sports, no matter from where they come.

After a playing career that fell achingly short of the major leagues, Lajoie returned to Detroit to become a teacher in the mid-1960s. But his unyielding passion for baseball and desire to atone for a broken dream pulled him back to the game as a scout. From there, he went on to build World Series Championships from scratch by finding players who possessed the very character he lacked as a young athlete. Starting as an area scout for the Cincinnati Reds in 1965, Lajoie later moved up the ladder with the Detroit Tigers and was the architect and general manager of their 1984 World Series crowning. Lajoie would then be instrumental as an assistant GM for two more franchises who dominated their decades with championships and titles; the 1990s Atlanta Braves and the 2000s Boston Red Sox. Perhaps no one alive has scouted more baseball over the last 50 years or has better stories to tell about finding the greats. Though the modern era has seen the depersonalization of scouting via statistics and radar gun readings, Lajoie was immensely successful through five decades by emphasizing what a player had inside him. His belief in a player's humanity and character persists to this day. This book is not only a biography, but a collection of great baseball stories and a manual for the next generation of fans and scouts alike. Lajoie tackles such controversial issues as the Moneyball movement, the importance of a strong manager, scouting for makeup, making trades, preventing pitching injuries, running a farm system, and ranking both the best general managers and scouting directors of the modern era.
