### THE EMERGENCE OF REFORMISM IN REVOLUTIONARY SYNDICALISM, 1871-1925

Springer This is a political biography of Alphonse Merrheim, a significant leader of the Confédération Générale du Travail (CGT) in the years between 1904 and 1923 and the most important member of the Federation of Metalworkers during the same period. He was born in the Nord in 1871 and became a worker at an early age, first in metallurgy than in textiles and finally once more in metalworking. In his ideological evolution he passed through a socialist political party and then converted to revolutionary syndicalism. In his peculiar fusion of theory and practice, Merrheim represented a form of revolutionary syndicalism that helps define the characteristics of that movement. He believed, along with other revolutionary syndicalists, that one day a workers' general strike would overthrow capitalism. But the syndicalist movement would prepare that eventuality by strengthening the workers through social reforms and by creating their class consciousness through education. Merrheim, however, participated so thoroughly in trade union activity and studied the organization of capitalist industry so carefully that he came to emphasize the preparations for such a general strike much more than the strike itself. The test of his attitude came on the eve of, during, and immediately after World War I; for contrary to the demands of certain militant and revolutionary workers who believed that the threat of war and the displacement caused by the war demanded a revolutionary response, Merrheim persistently stressed the dangers of such an action before the adequate preparation of the workers. His steadfast refusal to respond to the strike actions of some of his own metalworkers in 1919 indicates the central contradiction between his revolutionary theory and reformist practice. This book examines in detail Merrheim's evolution from a revolutionary to a reformer. In so doing it also sheds light on an equally substantial topic, namely, how a certain type of worker responded to industrialization in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. Merrheim is an interesting figure, too, because of his position in the labor movement, for it represents a unique focal point for the study of labor history. Merrheim entered the French labor movement in the 1890s and remained active in it until 1923. During that period he was, successively, a local union leader, co-secretary of a national labor federation, and an important figure within the CGT. Never the secretary-general of the CGT, he was nevertheless the confident of the secretary-general from 1909, Léon Jouhaux.

Library of Alexandria Before going into the history, &c., of playing cards, it may be as well to note the serious application that was made of them by some persons: and first, we will glance at the two sermons of Latimer's on cards, which he delivered in St Edward's Church, Cambridge, on the Sunday before Christmas Day 1529. In these sermons he used the card playing of the season for illustrations of spiritual truth. By having recourse to a series of similes, drawn from the rules of Primero and Trump, he illustrated his subject in a manner that for some weeks after caused his pithy sentences to be recalled at well nigh every social gathering; and his Card Sermons became the talk both of Town and University. The novelty of his method of treatment made it a complete success; and it was felt throughout the University that his shafts had told with more than ordinary effect. But, of course, these sermons being preached in pre-Reformation days, were considered somewhat heretical, and Buckenham, the Prior of the Dominicans at Cambridge, tried to answer Latimer in the same view. As Latimer derived his illustrations from Cards, so did Buckenham from Dice, and he instructed his hearers how they might confound Lutheranism by throwing quatre and cinque: the quatre being the four doctors of the Church, and the cinque being five passages from the New Testament selected by the preacher. Says Latimer in the first of these sermons: "Now then, what is Christ's rule? Christ's rule consisteth in many things, as in the Commandments, and the Works of Mercy and so forth. And for because I cannot declare

Christ's rule unto you at one time, as it ought to be done, I will apply myself according to your custom at this time of Christmas. I will, as I said, declare unto you Christ's rule, but that shall be in Christ's Cards. And, whereas you are wont to celebrate Christmas by playing at Cards, I intend, by God's grace to deal unto you Christ's Cards, wherein you shall perceive Christ's rule. The game that we will play at shall be called The Triumph, which, if it be well played at, he that dealeth shall win; the players shall likewise win; and the standers and lookers on shall do the same; insomuch that no man that is willing to play at this Triumph with these Cards, but they shall be all winners, and no losers.

He tells of the aborted homosexual sadism in Robert Musil; the murder, madrigals, and masochism in the life of composer Carlo Gesualdo; the iconography of leprosy; the iconography of Fanny Hill (or how to illustrate a dirty book); the melancholia of Johnson and Boswell; the short, miserable life of Rimbaud; and other mysteries to which medicine may hold the key.
