The musketeers numbered nearly three-fourths of Gustavus Adolphus's infantry. The Swedish order of battle was thus formed on the memorable field, of Lfitzen The Germans, in this battle, adhered to the heavy and deep phalanx formation. Under Charles II. (1660-85) the foot regiments were armed either with pikes or match locks or firelocks, and each soldier also carried a sword; they were later equipped with the hand grenade, whence the name 'grenadier Guards, ' the equipment being modernized while the name has been retained.
